Buffett News and Rumors

Buffett is working with scientists to convert used cooking oil from his Margaritaville restaurant in Myrtle Beach into fuel for shrimp boats.

Buffett attended Game 5 of the Lakers-Celtics NBA Championship Series.

The first Margaritaville Beach Hotel is scheduled to open July 1 in Pensacola Beach. The second will open in Myrtle Beach and a third is planned for Hollywood in South Florida.

Jimmy Buffett joined governor Charlie Crist on Pensacola Beach, talked about the oil spill and how he still plans to open his hotel there soon.

Jimmy sold his Palm Beach home to his billionaire neighbor, Jon Stryker, for \$18.5 million. He had purchased it for \$4.4 million in 1994 but it is currently appraised at \$23.3 million.

Buffett had planned to contribute four boats estimated at \$35,000 each to aid in recovery of oil-covered wildlife...but BP stopped the effort.

Jimmy Buffett performed for Michael Douglas as he collected a Chaplin Award at the AliceTully Hall Lincoln Centre. Margaritaville Foods announced they were going to add more chicken products with flavors such as Island Buffalo, Sweet & Sour Mango, and Spicy Orange.

Buffett is coming to Gulf Shores to promote awareness and tourism on July 1st for a free Concert at the Hang Out on the Beach. Guests include Sonny Landreth, Zac Brown Band, Kenny Chesney, Jesse Winchester and Allen Toussaint.

Poison lead singer and reality TV celebrity Bret Michaels joined Buffett on stage for a taste of "Margaritaville" in Detroit on June 22.

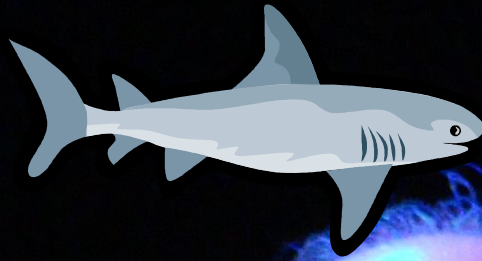
